Networking threatened forest from Tasmania to the world

A media centre like no other – 50 metres high among the tall trees of Tasmania's Western Wilderness. This forest should have been protected by the moratorium (March 2011) and the conservation agreement

(August 2011) and is now open for logging before the end of the year.

Still Wild Still Threatened has constructed a treetop media centre 50 metres off the ground, fully equipped with the technology to record and broadcast logging operations.
